



Dear Brother <LAST\_NAME>,

In February I reported on the strength of Kappa Chapter. Here is a summary of that report, with updates:

- We have 1,030 living Kappa alumni up from 950 in August 2020. We have contact information for over 80% of the alumni.
- The Actives initiated a class of 15 in F'21, bringing the total number of Actives (living in or outside the house) to 62! They initiated another 14 in Sp '22 and they expect to have over 30 living in the house for F'22. For F'19, there were 16.
- For Founder's Day, we celebrated (in person and virtually) the life of Brother Dan Stearns ('74) a member of the Alumni Board for 33 years and a former Adviser to the Actives. In addition, for the third year in a row, we awarded scholarships. For this year, four \$1,000 scholarships were awarded, one for each of the Cardinale Principles and a fourth for Man of the Year.
- Our finances are in strong shape. The mortgage debt has been reduced to about \$200,000 and we are on track to pay it off by no later than the end of 2023.

In addition to the above, I am pleased to report that the Kappa alumni have provided significant financial support during this giving year (8/1/21 through 7/31/22), totaling \$13,579 through 4-30-22. As I have noted before, we manage to two budgets - a housing budget and an alumni association budget. In this way, we first ensure that the housing-related expenses are covered by payments from the Actives, and that alumni donations are targeted just to alumni needs and activities, such as communications costs, the Scholarship Fund, and the alumni events. The alumni budget for this giving year is \$25,000. Please accept my sincere thanks for your support to date. But as you can see, we do have some need to fill.

I hope and trust that you and your loved ones are safe and healthy at this time, and as we move forward to a level of normalcy. I also take this moment to ask for your support, to the extent that you are able. The fraternity experience is truly a valuable and unique experience, fully worthy of continuation. I thank you for your past support and thank you in advance for your continued support.
